



The club was established when the ladies team representing Wimbledon F.C. chose to join AFC Wimbledon following the relocation of the former club.

On Sunday, October 24, 2021, AFC Wimbledon secured a 7–1 victory against Walton Casuals in the FA Cup 3rd qualifying round, marking their inaugural match at the main Plough Lane Stadium.

Originally named AFC Wimbledon Ladies, the club rebranded as "AFC Wimbledon Women" before the start of the 2022–23 season.

In April 2024, the club was crowned champions of Division One South East, earning promotion to the Premier Division South for the 2024–25 season.

HEAD-TO-HEAD

This afternoon is the sixth meeting between Billericay Town and AFC Wimbledon, with the first coming in September 2018, a 1-0 home win for The Blues. The Dons won the return leg, 2-1.

The most recent meeting came in the F.A. Cup in November 2022. Wimbledon won the match 2-0.

Of those five matches both sides have two wins with a 0-0 draw played at Plough Lane. Town have scored 4 goals with Wimbledon scoring 5.

In Wimbledon's squad is former Blue, Leanne Bell.

Leanne joined us last season and was part of the team that lifted the Isthmian Women's Cup.

Leanne made 31 starts, 1 sub appearance and scored 3 goals.
